

Windows® Media Center Interface Software

The Crestron Windows Media Center Interface software lets you select and control the audio and video sources available on a Windows Media Center installed as part of the Crestron control system. A friendly, onscreen, customizable menu can be displayed on any Crestron touchpanel and is compatible with any Crestron® 2-Series control system.

The main page provides easy browsing and instant access to all the music and video sources available via the Windows Media Center. The main page is the first level of browsing, and provides 'jump-to' buttons that display pages showing category lists (Genres, Artists, Albums, Tracks, Playlists, and Video). A Remote Control button displays a virtual remote control device for controlling available video sources, including live TV. The Now Playing button that displays a page that provides detailed information about the music or video currently playing (for example, title, album, artist, duration and elapsed time).

Music selection can be made based on any of several categories: genres, artists, albums, tracks, and playlists.

Selecting a genre, artist, or album, displays a page listing all the tracks available in that selection. Selecting one of the tracks displays the "What would you like to play" screen, allowing you to choose just the selected item, all the items in the list, or cancel so you can make a different selection. The tracks selection page lists all available tracks. The album title appears under the track title; the artist's name appears to the right. The playlists selection page lists custom combinations of music and/or video that have been created on the Windows Media Center. The Video button allows viewing of recorded video available on the Windows Media Center. The browser screen displays all available video sources.

Site Licensing, available from Crestron, is required for this program. In addition, you will need the control system IP address and the IP ID for setup.
