The Crestron® [HD-MD421](#) is a 4K60 4:2:0 multiformat AV switcher that provides a cost-effective solution for professional AV applications. The HD-MD421 includes four HDMI® inputs, two DM Lite® inputs, and one mirrored HDMI and DM Lite output.

Install the Device

The device occupies 1 RU of rack space in a 19-inch equipment rack.

WARNING: To prevent bodily injury when mounting or servicing the unit in a rack:

- When mounting the unit into a partially filled rack, load the rack from the bottom to the top with the heaviest component at the bottom of the rack.

- If the rack is provided with stabilizing devices, install the stabilizers before mounting or servicing the unit in the rack.

NOTE: Observe the following rack mount installation guidelines:

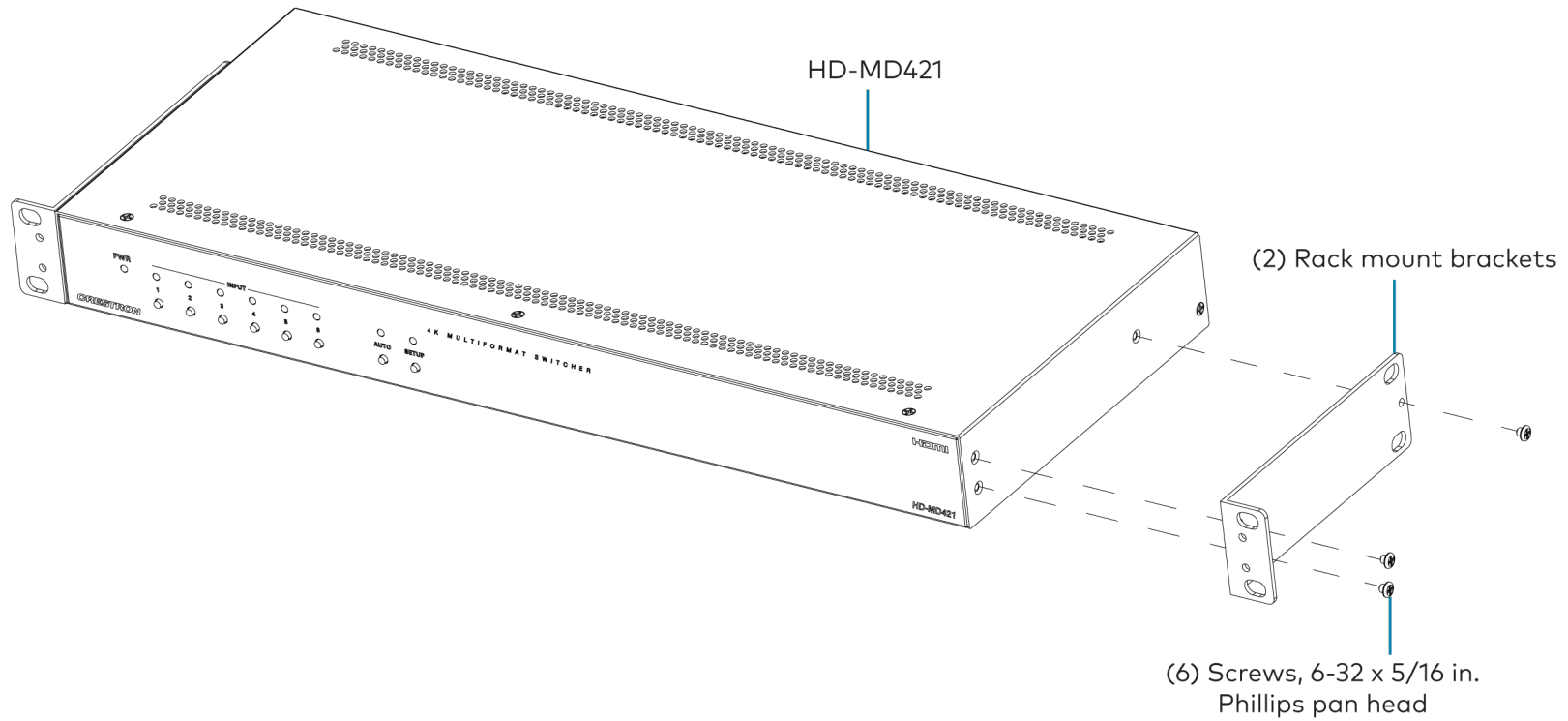
- **Elevated Operating Ambient Temperature:** If installed in a closed or multi-unit rack assembly, the operating ambient temperature of the rack environment may be greater than room ambient temperature. Therefore, consideration should be given to installing the equipment in an environment compatible with the maximum ambient temperature (T_{ma}) specified by the manufacturer.
- **Reduced Airflow:** Installation of the equipment in a rack should be such that the amount of airflow required for safe operation of the equipment is not compromised.
- **Mechanical Loading:** Mounting of the equipment in the rack should be such that a hazardous condition is not achieved due to uneven mechanical loading.
- **Circuit Overloading:** Consideration should be given to the connection of the equipment to the supply circuit and the effect that overloading of the circuits might have on overcurrent protection and supply wiring. Appropriate consideration of equipment nameplate ratings should be used when addressing this concern.
- **Reliable Earthing:** Reliable earthing of rack-mounted equipment should be maintained. Particular attention should be given to supply connections other than direct connections to the branch circuit (e.g., use of power strips).

To mount the device into a rack:

1. Attach the two included rack mount brackets to the switcher using the six included 6-32 x 5/16-inch Phillips pan head screws (three screws for each side of the device).
2. Mount the device into a rack using four rack mount screws (two screws per bracket, not included).

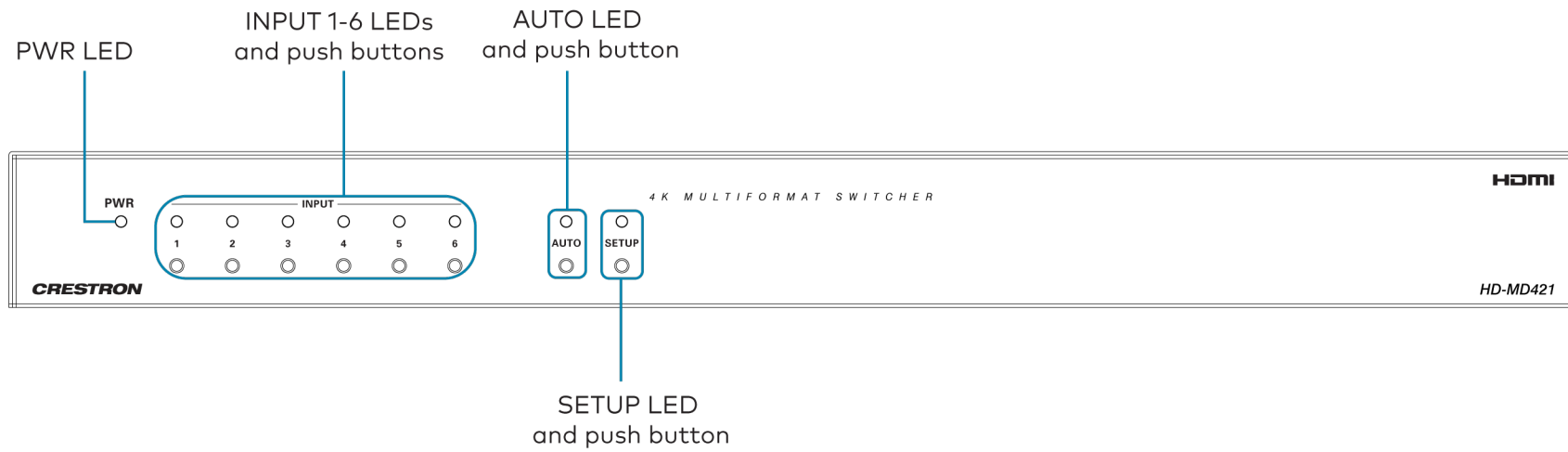

Front Panel

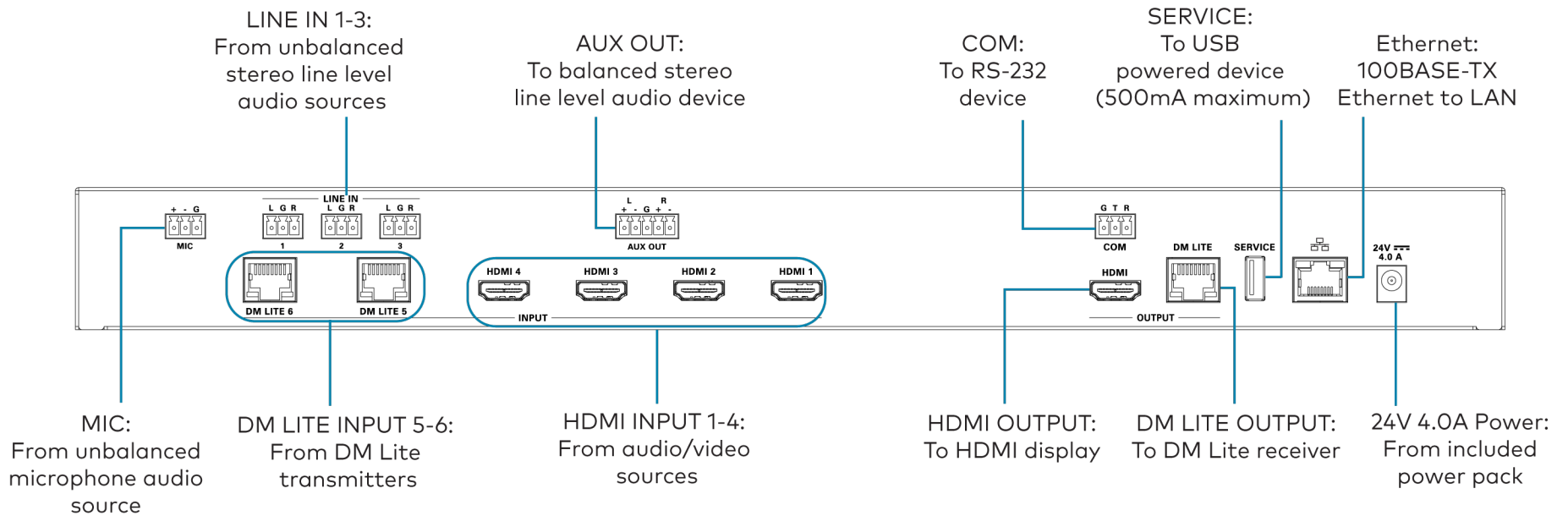

Connect the Device

Connect the rear panel of the device as required for the application.

Rear Panel Connections

NOTES:

- The HDMI and DM LITE outputs provide a mirrored output that displays the same image on two display devices.
- Supported DM Lite transmitters are the [HD-TX-101-C-E](#) and [HD-TX-101-C-1G-E](#).
- Supported DM Lite receivers are the [HD-RX-101-C-E](#), [HD-RXC-101-C-E](#), [HD-RX-101-C-1G-E](#), and [HD-RXC-101-C-1G-E](#).
- The power connection powers the HD-MD421 and all devices connected to the DM Lite input and output ports. Power should not be connected to the HD-MD421 and DM Lite devices simultaneously.



Upgrade the Firmware

Before using the device, upgrade the firmware. The latest firmware can be downloaded from the [HD-MD421](#) product page on the Crestron website (www.crestron.com).



Configure the Device

Configure the device using the web interface. To access the web interface, open a web browser and then go to the IP address of the device.

NOTE: By default, the IP address of an HD-MD421 device is assigned by a DHCP server on the network. If a DHCP server does not exist on the network, the IP address defaults to a link-local address in the 169.254.xxx.xxx range. To display the IP address on the connected display, press the **SETUP** button on the front panel of the device.

If no account has been created, create an account by entering a user name and password. After an account is created, log in to the web interface by entering the user name and password.

Observe the LED Indicators

Refer to the following table for information about the LED indicators on the device.

LED Indicator	Color	Meaning
PWR	Amber	Power is being applied to the device. The device is booting.
	Green	Power is being applied to the device. The device is operational.
AUTO	Green	Automatic switching is enabled.
SETUP	Red	The SETUP button is pressed.
Ethernet	Green	A 100BASE-TX link is established.
	Flashing amber	Data activity is occurring on the Ethernet link.
INPUT 1-6	Green	The corresponding input is routed to an output.
	Amber	A source is detected at the corresponding input but is not routed to an output.
DM LITE OUTPUT	Green	A DM Lite link is established.
	Flashing amber	Non-HDCP video is detected.
	Solid amber	HDCP video is detected.
