Crestron Audio & Video makes Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers the place to be on game day

Established in 2011, Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers' goal has been to take customers back in time to a classic neighborhood burger joint. A local place where the staff is on a first name basis with every customer, and you can easily walk or ride a bike home.

Beyond serving a variety of house-blended specialty burgers and drinks, Cold Beers & Cheeseburgers is known for having plenty of televisions constantly tuned to sports coverage, including games on DIRECTV® NFL Sunday Ticket®.

The 5,000 square-foot burger bar is growing rapidly, with three locations opened, one on the way, and a food truck. Scottsdale-based integration firm Clean Media AV is behind the technology in the storefront locations.

Clean Media's reputation for implementing advanced AV and control systems in area restaurants and sports bars caught the attention of restaurateur Barrett Rinzler. Rinzler wanted to be able to easily control the 44 TVs in the new Chandler, AZ location on-the-fly, while also ensuring superior sound throughout the restaurant and on the outdoor patio.



Systems at a glance

"A busy sports bar needs great sound, so we installed Crestron SAROS® 8-inch surface mount-speakers throughout, plus Crestron control to manage the entire system. We programmed the system so that any of the staff members can easily switch channels or control the volume," said Tom Yario, Clean Media AV Director of Operations. "Staff can control the AV using the 22-inch Crestron touch screen at the equipment rack, or with the restaurant iPad®."

Crestron provides AV control to 44 TVs and four audio zones. "Anyone can come watch any game at any time. You aren't stuck watching only certain games because there are only so many displays. Customer have have plenty of options," says Dylan Vicha, Clean Media AV Owner.

Crestron technology helps to uphold the restaurant's mission to provide a hometown look and feel, while providing the ultimate in entertainment. Cold Beers and Cheeseburgers' managers and hosts can focus on serving quality food and drinks, instead of spending time worrying about changing channels or raising and lowering the volume.

Other side of the coin

"It may seem like a small detail to simply turn on TV's, change the channel, and adjust volume levels, but this can be time consuming when you have 40+ TVs. "If there wasn't a control system, someone would have to turn on all the TVs and choose the channel for every single one. The staff doesn't have to worry about setting everything up or looking for a remote to open or close the restaurant every day," notes Vicha.
